Terms of Reference - Policy Committee

Role

The policy committee at KIMS is a committee established by the Secretary General by an administrative decree (2/2015) to establish policies and procedures related to postgraduate training and examination. The committee report drafted policies to the Secretary General to be approved by the Scientific Council.

Responsibility and Authority

The policy committee is responsible to the Secretary General and the Scientific Council. The Policy Committee is responsible for:

- Draft the policies and procedures for training programs.
- Review admission, training and examination policies of the training programs.
- Review the appeal policies for admission, in-training evaluation and examinations.
- Review policies on leaves and leave of absence.
- Establish the policies and procedure achieve and update it.

Composition of the Committee

This committee will be comprised of representatives of KIMS educational Offices and program directors to represents the medical and surgical specialties as follows

Resident Representative

Term of Office

The usual term of office of the chair for three years. The chair is appointed by the Secretary General. The usual term of office of members is three years

Meetings

The Policy Committee meetings will be conducted at least once a year and as needed. Quorum consists of a majority of the voting members of the committee (50% plus one). The chair shall only vote when the vote is conducted by secret ballot or when it is necessary to break a tie.
